

German Language Course for Refugees

You want to study at Leipzig University, but your German isn't good enough yet? Leipzig University offers **free German language courses for refugees as a preparation for university studies** which start in **April 2018**. The course period is six to nine months and the courses lead to the language level C1. A placement test will be held mid-March.

What do I need in order to take part in a course?

- knowledge of the German language, **level B1** (e.g. via an 'Integrationskurs' or similar, the B1-certificate has to be handed in 28 February 2018 the latest)
- a direct **university admission qualification** (secondary school certificate or first university degree)
- specification of your **preferred study programme at Leipzig University**

Where can I apply?

Please apply via uni assist e.V.:

- 1 For the application it is necessary to prove a **TestAS** (Test for Academic Studies - <https://refugees.testas.de/>) or a "**Beratungsschein**" (obtainable after presenting your certificates in a counselling during our office hours).
- 2 After a successful registration with uni-assist you can apply for the '**German language course for refugees**'. The **application period** is **15th November 2017 – 31st December 2017**.
